## Forward Sunapee: Housing Meeting #2 Abbott Library 12/19 9 a.m.

- Rentals in Sunapee as of today; 4.
  - 105 houses have sold in the last 3 years under \$500,000 in Sunapee (condos, multi-family, single family)
  - 30 in the last 12 months 30 under \$500,000.
  - 1 property for sale 12.18 under \$500,000
  - o 36 houses under \$300,000 in the last 3 years
- Low Income definition 30% of your annual income; median male income os \$32,000 in female, \$27,000 household \$70,000 Sullivan
  - None in Sunapee, 15 within 30 miles, 7 are senior housing (most in Newport and Claremont)
- Need is low income, senior, workforce
  - Definition of workforce
